- 3. QUESTIONS:
  - 3.1. What is the weight rating of the bridge leading into Torry Island?
    3.1.1. 80,000 lbs.
  - 3.2. In the bid docs it states "vendor must hold a Certificate of Competency issued by the State of Florida or the Palm Beach County Construction Industry Licensing". We are a registered vendor with Palm Beach Co. and have a state of Florida GC License. Are these sufficient to fulfil this? If not, how do we obtain a Certificate of Competency?

    3.2.1.A State of Florida GC license will satisfy the requirement
  - 3.3. is a CPA reviewed financial statement sufficient versus a Certified Financial Statement?

    3.3.1.An Audited or Certified Financial Statement is necessary to fulfill the requirement. A

    CPA reviewed Financial Statement commonly called a compilation is not acceptable.
  - 3.4. Based on the geotechnical report we think the composite sheet pile will have difficulty penetrating the hard stratas shown. Does the City anticipate pre forming along the footprint of the sheet pile? We feel auguring ahead of driving the sheet pile will be needed to get sheets into proper embed and enough space for rebar.
    3.4.1.Refer to addendum #1 numbers 15 and 16.
  - 3.5. Would the City be open to receiving Value Engineering for a cantilevered sheet pile alternate?

    3.5.1.No alternatives to the proposed sea wall system are being accepted other than products/system that are "approved equal" (cantilevered sheet pile is not an approved equal system).

- 3.6. In regard to addendum no. 1 Q&A #15 the engineer specifies the use of pin piles if the sheet cannot reach the minimum depth required and then copy and pasted a picture off of truline's website. This answer did not provide any engineering in regard to the material type, size, length, embedment depth, etc. Without this information it will leave the contractor to assume these items and will result in a wide range of bid prices with the lowest price more than likely inadequate for the anticipated loads. Could you please have the engineer specify exactly what they are looking for?
  - 3.6.1. The basis of design calls for 14'-0" min. embedment of Truline 800 Series Vinyl Sheet piles which was designed as per the Geotechnical report/information. If this is not achievable (as per field conditions) then the system must be installed as per the manufacturer's recommendations and designed (material type, size, length, embedment depth, etc.) per Contractor's specialty Engineer. Signed and sealed design calculations must be provided for review and approval (typical construction practice).
